


पृष्टांकन का सारांश










TRUST"

WHEREAS the Settlor and Founder Trustees are desirious of establishing a Trust for public charitable objects and whereas the Trustees have, at the request of Settlor, agreed to act as the fOUNDER Trustees of these presents as testified by their being parties to and executing these presents.

And whereas it is necessary to declare the objects and terms of the public charitable trust being constituted under these presents.

Now this indenture witnesseth as follows:

That, in order to effectuate his aforesaid desire, the settler has set apart and handed over to the Trust, a sum of Rs. 50,000/-(Fifty thousand only) (herein after only) (hereinafter called the "Trust Fund" which expression shall include cash and any other property or investments of any kind whatsoever into which the same or any part thereof might be converted invested or varid from time to time or which may be acquired by the Trustees or may cometo their hands by virtue of these presents or by operation of law or otherwise how so ever in relation to these presents) and the Trustees shall hold and stand possessed of the same upon the Trust objects to the powers, provisions agreements and declarations hereinafter contained.

1. Name: The name of the trust shall be S.M. Educational & Social Development Trust" (Hereinafter known as Trust). The may be change it if they mutually so decided in future.

2. Registered Office: The registered office of the Trust shall be located In Daudnagar, Aurangabad district and at present shall be placed at Village-Vidya Niketan Shuk Bazar Ward no.12 Daudnagar P.o+P.s. Daudnagar District-Aurangabad (Bihar) And it can be changed at such other places as the Board of Trustees may decide from time to time.

3. **Area of operation**: The operational area of the Trust shall be whole India and may be reduced or expanded as the trustees may decide.

4. Administrative Office, Branches or Project Offices: Trust may have administrative office or branches or project offices in such place or places as decided by the Chairman of Trust or Board of Trustees time to time within the operational area of the Trust under the overall guidance and control of the registered office.

5. Funds of the Trust: The assets, together with all further donations, contributions, grant and loan in any shape or form made to the said trust from time to time, and the rents, the stocks, funds and properties representing the same shall be held by the Trustees upon Trust for the objects and purposes and subject to powers and provisions hereinafter set out.

6. Objects of the Trust:

Trust will extend its servies without discriminating the caste, creed, race and religion but special emphasis will be given on educationally backward in particular and weaker sections in general. The objects of Trust are to:

- 6.1 Establish, run, develop and management of hospital medical schools and colleges, pharmacy and dental colleges, nursing institution,s para medical, health education institutions, polytechnic, industrial training institutes dispensaries, maternity homes, technical or non-technical institutions like Information Technology & Engineering colleges, management institutes, child or women welfare, centres and/or such similar institutions in India for the benefit of the general public.
- 6.2 Establish, run, Develop manage, assist and supportSchools including boarding school from primary to university level, Colleges, libraries, reading rooms, laboratories, research and other institutions of the like nature in India for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the general.

Stipends, medals and other incentives to student books, without any distinction as to caste, colour, race creed or sex.

Promote, establish, run or manage higher educational 6.4 institutions for the promotion of science and technology, literature, music, drama and fine arts in management, India for the benefit of the public in general.

Establish, run, maintain or manage for the establishment and/or, 6.5 maintenance of parks, gardens, gymnasiums, sports clubs, dharamashalas and rest houses for use by public in general.

Establish, run, maintain or manage shelter homes, orphanages or 6.6 other establishments for the relief and help to the poor, needy destitute people, orphans, widows, aged persons and children. helpless

Establish, run, maintain or manage institutions or centres for the 6.7 physically handicapped and disabled or mentally retarded and to provide them education, food, clothing or persons other helps.

Extend relief work and assist to the needy victims during natural 6.8 calamities such as famine, earthquake, flood, fire, pestilence etc. and to give assistance to institutions, establishments or persons engaged in such relief work.

-6.9 Organize or promote programmes of Training in Social Work as and when required and also to study and analyse Govt. plan policies and social problems requiring urgent intervention sureveys, research and evaluation in such manner through as amy be considered necessary.

-6.10 Promote, conduct undertake or participate in national and seminars, events. exhibitions. museums, international conferences and conventions.

Establish, maintain, manage institutions and research centre or 6.11 implement programmes or centres for:

-Promotion of Indian system of Medicine & homeopathy, Yoga, Sidha, Unani, Naturopathy and other system of medicine.

-Vocational Training in approved courses of National council of Vocational Training and other Govt department.

-Engineering & technology/ Pharmacy/ Architecture/Town Planning/ Hotel Management & catering Technology/Applied Arts and craft and MCA in approved courses of All Indian Council of Technical Education(AICTE)

-Teacher education in approved courses of National council of Teacher Education [Pre School Teacher Education Programme, Nursery Teacher Education Programme, Elementary Teacher Education

Programme, Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed) Secondary Teacher Education Programme (B.Ed.) Master of Education Programme (M.Ed) Master of Education programme (M.Ed) Part time, Certificate in physical Education Programme (C.P.Ed), Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed) programme, Master of Physical Education programme, B.Ed.(open and distance learning system)]

-Promotion of animal husbandry, Bee keeping, agro industry and other micro rural industry.

-Acceleration of food processing industry and preservation of fruits and vegetables.

-Health and family welfare, Adolescent health care, HIV/AIDS, S.T.D. Leprosy, Tuberculosis, and cancer etc.

-Promotion and expansion of handicrafts.

-Welfare and protection of consumer's right

-Self help group of men and women for their development and socioeconomic change.

-Check of atrocities against women and children.

-Eradication of child labour problem and rehabilitation of bonded labour.

-Control of environmental pollution.

-Irrigation of agricultural land, co-operative marketing processing and storage along with development of rural growth centres.

-Dramatic, film making, acting and performing art and audio- visual screening process technique.

-Rain water harvesting and watershed management.

6.12 Promote or organize or implement activities for the promotion of cultivation of aromatic and medical plants, horticulture, social forestry and forest expansion.


6.13 Make efforts for information dissemination, R & D, to expedite the non-conventional source of energy.

6.14 Promote and execute activities like sanitation, water supply rural health, construction of road and other activities for rural development when ever necessary.

6.15 Promote, produce, sale and advertise khadi products and village industries as approved by khadi & Village Industries- Commission.

6.16 Promote, produce, sale and advertise audi0-visual software film for furtherance of aforesaid objects.

6.17 To conduct poor feedingand generally give food and relief to the poor needy and disable person and to afford relief work to people in distress due to natural calamity. accident, earthquake, flood, famine, epidemics and grant donation for the support of orphanage and welfare institution and may also carry on rehabilitation programmes.



6.18 To carry on community development programmes for the upliftment of the economically weaker section of the society and also construct and develop community centre or hall for carrying such activities.

6.19 Provide consultancy, placement and advisory services, undertake all acts, deeds and things connected with incidental to and germane to the aforesaid objects.

7. Board of Trustees:

The Trust shall be vested in a Board of Trustees (hereinafter called the Board) which shall consist of not less than three and not more than seven trustees. The first Trustees constituting the Board are:

1.Smt. Yashoda Devi

2.Sri Suresh Kumar Gupta

3.Smt. Malti Devi

4.Mr. Vikram Prakash

5.Mr.Pankaj Kumar

6.Smt. Rekha Gupta

7594.Md. Mozahir Alam

7.1 The Board of Trustees shall have one Chairman. The First Chairman of the Board will be Smt. Yashoda Devi and Secrectary Sri Suresh Kumar Gupta.

The term of all other trustees shall be of five years.

7.2 The first trustees constituting the Board shall have the power to increasethe strength of the Board by appointing thereto one or more person on the recommendation of Chairman whether on the same occasion or on different occasions, as trustee or trustees, but the total number of persons constituting the Board shall at no time exceed seven.

7.3 In the event of vacancy in the office of chairman, the Board shall

elect a Chairman amongst themselves.

7.4 If any of the Trustee shall die, or desire to retire, refuse or become incapacitated to act as a Trustee or take the benefit of insolvency Law, then and in every such case, there shall be a vacancy in the Board.

7.5 A Trustee may be removed from his office in the following grounds.

(i) if the trustte becomes unfit or personally incapable to act in the trust.

(ii) if found guilty of (a) misconduct or abuse of office, (b) acting dishonestly or fraudulently



(c) misappropriation of trust funds,(d) moral turpitude (e) application of trust property to private purposes etc.

A Trustee may be removed by a resolution adopted by two third majority of the members of the Board present and voting at a meeting specially called for the purpose. The Trustee affected shall be given reasonable opportunity to show cause against the proposed action.

Vacancies in the Board may be filled by the remaining Trustees at a meeting called for the purpose. Casual vacancies in the Board may be filled in the manner aforesaid for the unexpired part of the term of the Trustee causing the vacancy. A retiring trustee shall be eligible for re-election on the recommendation of Chairman.

The quorum for a meeting of the Board shall be 1/3rd of the existing members If the meeting have not a quorum within one hour of the fixed time the meeting shall be adjourned to the same day and time at the same place for the next week. Adjourned meeting shall not require having a quorum.

Vacancies in the Board shall not invalidate the any of the 7.8

proceedings of the Board.

The Board may meet as often as necessary but not less than twice in a calendar year and their proceeding shall be recorded regularly in minute's book to retain for purpose. In any resolution to be passed touching the administration of the Trust, the opinion of the majority shall prevail. It shall be competent however for the Trustee to decide matters by circulation. In case there being equality of votes the chairman of the meeting has casting votes for the purpose of deciding the issue.

Decisions at the meeting of the Board shall be taken by the 7.10 majority of the trustees presen by unanimous decision or voting. In the caseof equality of votes, the Chairman of the Board shall have a second

or casting vote. The trustee may frame rule and regulation as to the duties and responsibilities of each Trustee, to appoint sub committees with the administration of the Trust and its management.

The managing Trustee or his nominee or any other Trustee so authorized by the board of trustees shall have the custody of all the document, deeds, title relating to the Trust properties and investment

and the book of account and other records relating to the Trust and

shall be responsible to the preservation of the same.

Notice shall be served personally or sent by post to the Board of Trustees seven days prior for all type of meetings.

8. Power and Functions of the Board of Trustees:-

8.1 To accept any donation, contribution, grant, loan or subscription in cash or kind, from any person(s) body of Persons or Trust, Govt. Semi-Govt. department or agency,national or international donor, with or without conditions.

8.2 To apply the whole or any part of the Trust-Fund or accumulations thereto, to anyone or more of the obljects of the Trust, as the Trustees may, in their discretion deem fit from time to time.

8.3 To convert and deal with the Trust property and/or any investments for the time being.

8.4 To invest the Trust-Fund either in the purpose of mortgage of immovable property or in shares, Stock or debentures or other securities and investments, or in deposits with or loans to any company, bank firm or any other person and to alter, vary or transpose such investments, from time to time at the discretion of the Board of Trustees.

8.5 To borrow or raise or secure payments of money and also to lend money either wlith or without security


8.6 To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration, all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust-Fund.

8.7 To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate Trustees to hold any fund or investment. Subject to the provisions of this Deed in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees amy from time to time think fit.

8.8 To make vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furthereance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.

8.9 To settle all accounts and to compromise, compound abandon, or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes claim, demand or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.

8.10. To apply to the Government, public bodies, urban, local,municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts subscriptions, and other assistance with a view to promoting the objects



of the Trust andto discuss and negotiate with the Government departments public and other bodies corporations, companies or persons, schemes and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to conform to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.

To establish regulate or discontinue branches, centres or projects, offices within India or appointing representatives or agents or advisory committees.

To subscribe to become a member of or otherwise cooperate with any other Trust or its branch whether incorporated or not whose objects are either wholly or in part similar to those of the Trust or which could promote the interest of the Trust.

8.13 The Trustees shall, from and out of the fund realized from the properties, assets and funds of Trust and from other such endowments and from the Government grants and from any other sources which they may get expend such sum or sums of money as they may deem proper towards the maintenance of the properties of the Trust, pay all rates and taxes, pay such sums towards the repayments of any borrowing by the Trustees and meet all expenses which the Trustees may their discretion think necessary for the proper and efficient management of the Trust and in particular pay the salaries and allowance of all staff and servants, purchase of books, equipments and furniture's pay management contribution for the Provident Fund of the staff gratuity, pension etc. awards; prizes or scholarships to students and incur any other item of expenditure, relating to the institutions, if any, under the management of the Trust not here in before specially mentioned. it being understood that the above enumeration gives not priority to any particular item of expense nor is the same exhaustive.

No part of the Trust property or any accretion there to shall be applied for any purpose which is not a charitable purpose in law, and all provisions hereof shall be controlled accordingly.

The Board of Trustees have management of the affairs of the Trust and the overall supervision and superintendence of the Trust and all institutions run by the Trust and all matters incidental there to.

No part of the Trust property or its income or any accretion there to shall be applied for any purpose which is not a charitable purpose in law, and all provisions hereof shall be controlled accordingly.

9. Accounts and Audit:

9.1 The account or accounts of the Trust shall be opened by the name of the Trust and/or branches, project offices centres or institutions run or conducted by the Trust with a Nationalized or

Scheduled bank or other bank approved or permitted by Reserve Bank of India or in Post Office and it shall be operated by one or more of the Trustees or such person authorized by Board of Trustees time to time.

9.2 The accounts of the Trust shall be audited every year by a Charatered Accountant or a firm of Chartered Accountant that will be appointed by the Board of Trustees with the consultation of the chairman.

9.3 The audited accounts of the Trust shall be adopted at the meering of the Board of Trustees called for the purpose and remuneration of Chartered Accountant or Firm of Chartered Accountants shall be fixed by the Board of Trustees.

10 Power to amalgate:

The Board of Trustees may allow and permit any other Trust. Institution or Charity, in any local area or areas whose objects are either wholly or in part similar to those of these presents to the intent and effect that such other Trust, Institution or charity shall be deemed to be a part and parcel of the Trust created by these Presents provided that no conditions are accepted which involve a change in the name of this Trust or inconsistent with or repugnant to the objectes of this Trust.

11 Indemnity:

11.1 The Trustees shall be chargeable only for such money, stocks funds deposits and securities as they shall actually receive, not with standing their signing any receipt for the sake of conformity and shall be answerable or accountable only for their own deliberate or willful acts of omission or commission.

11.2 No Trustee shall be liable for any breach of trust committed by the Co-trustee except in respect of his own act and in respect of any property in his custody.

12 Power to Reimburse:

The Trustees of these Present are entitled to be-reimbursed and also to pay and discharge out of the Trust-Fund, all expenses incurred by them or on their behalf in or about the execution of the Trust and the powers of these present.

13 Allowance to Trustees & Office-bearers:

If at any time any Trustee acts as a whole time office bearer of the Trust or renders any special service, the Board of Trustees may in its discretion pay such remuneration or allowances to such Trustee as it may think proper.



14 Accounting year of the Trust:

The accounting year of the Trust shall be the financial year ending on 31st March every year.

15. Amendments:

This Trust, Trust-Fund and the provisions relating to the appointment of the first Chairman of the Board are irrevocable. Subject as aforesaid the terms of this deed may be amended, altered of modified by a majority of 2/3rd members of the Board present and voting in a meeting called for the purpose.

Provided, however, that no amendment contrary to the objects of the Trust hereinbefore set forth shall be valid and effective.

16. Interpretation of the terms of this deed of Trust:

That in caseof any disputes as regarding interpretation of any terms of this **DEED OF TRUST** among the Trustee or between ny Trustees and the Managing Trustee it shallbe solved as per the provision of the INDIAN Registration Trust Act, 1882.

17 Advisory Body:


The Trustee may maintain a set of advisors for the purpose of utilizing their services in furtherance of the objects of the Trust.

18 Jurisdiction of Courts:

The competent court in Daudnagar, Aurangabad (Bihar)

shall have exclusive jurisdiction to decide any question regarding the interpretation and construction of this Deed or administration of the Trust and the relate matters. In the event of such courts having concurrent jurisdiction with any other court or courts in respect of any claim or dispute against or by the Trust or Trustees or any other matter connected therewith, the competent courts in Daudnagar, Aurangabad (Bihar), shall have jurisdiction to entertain, try and determine such claim or dispute in exclusion of such other court or courts.
